

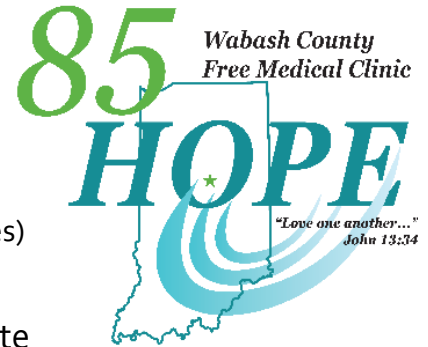
Thank you for your interest in 85 HOPE Free Medical Clinic!

We serve people who are:

- Adults ages 18-64
- Residents of Wabash County
- Low-income (200% or less of poverty level)
- Uninsured or under-insured (high premiums/co-pays/deductibles)

We provide:

- Free medical care, medications, and physical therapy on-site
- Free labs, X-rays, and mammograms at Parkview Wabash Hospital
- Referrals for dental, eye, mental health counseling, and other specialties
- Assistance applying for Medicaid/HIP



To become a patient:

- **Call 260-274-0011** to schedule an intake appointment or **walk-in** during office hours on **Tuesday/Thursday afternoons 1-5 pm.**
- **If you don't have access to paperwork or if you have no permanent address, please call us or stop by the office. We will be happy to assist you.**
- Please provide the following documentation (bring only what applies to you):
 - Photo ID
 - Evidence of Wabash County residence (legitimate piece of mail—bill, bank statement, etc.)
 - Evidence of all monthly income **for past 30 days** for client and spouse (paper or phone):
 - Employment: Pay stubs, Worker's Comp, Pension/retirement
 - Government: Social Security, SSDI, SSI, Unemployment, Veteran's benefits
 - Domestic: Alimony/child support
 - Other assets or income
 - Evidence of monthly payments **for past 30 days** for client and spouse (paper or phone):
 - Domestic: Alimony/child support
 - Insurance: Insurance card, policy, premiums (only if you have insurance)
- **Medications: Please bring ALL BOTTLES of prescription and over-the-counter medications and vitamin/herbal supplements to your intake appointment and first medical appointment.**
- At your intake appointment, we will make copies of your paperwork, assess your financial status and eligibility, record your health history, and then schedule an appointment for you with a provider on Thursday evenings between 5-8 pm.
